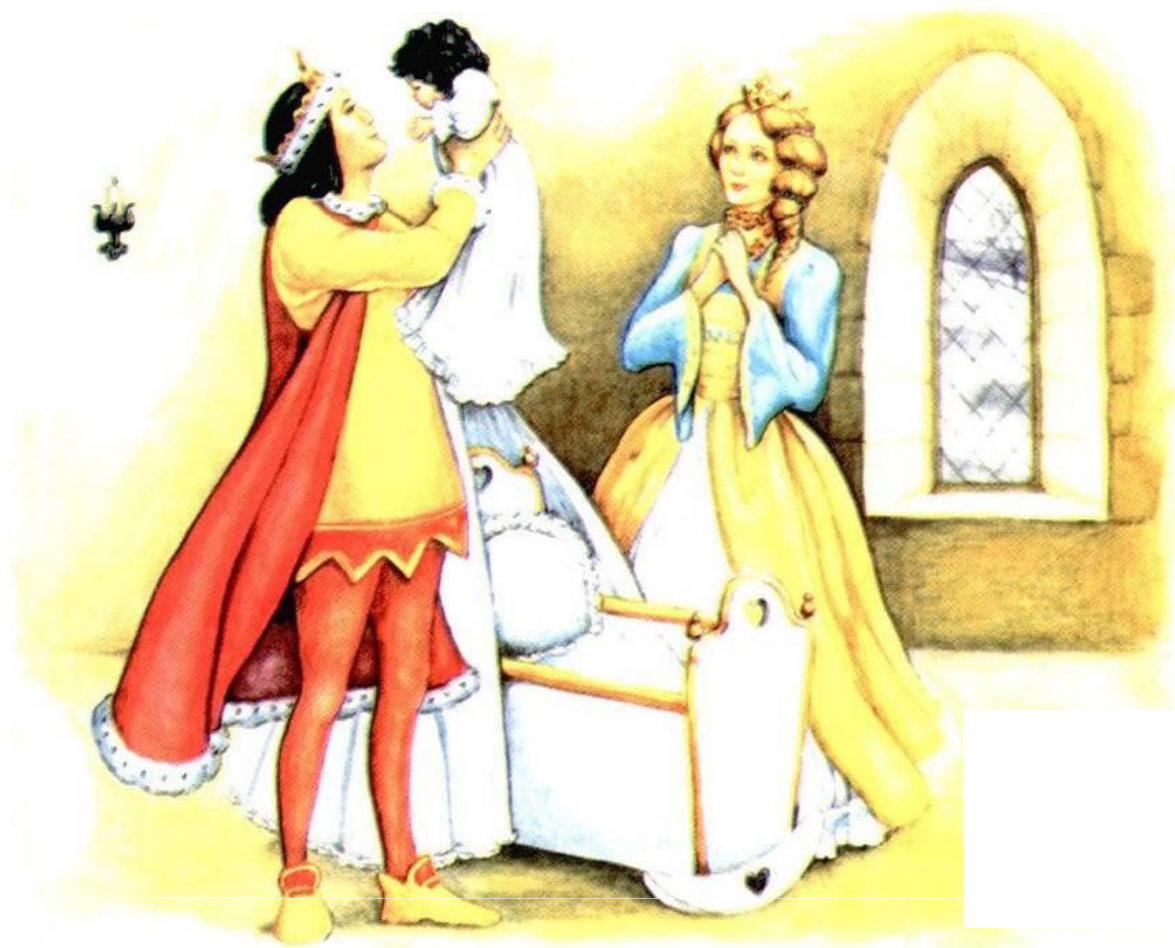

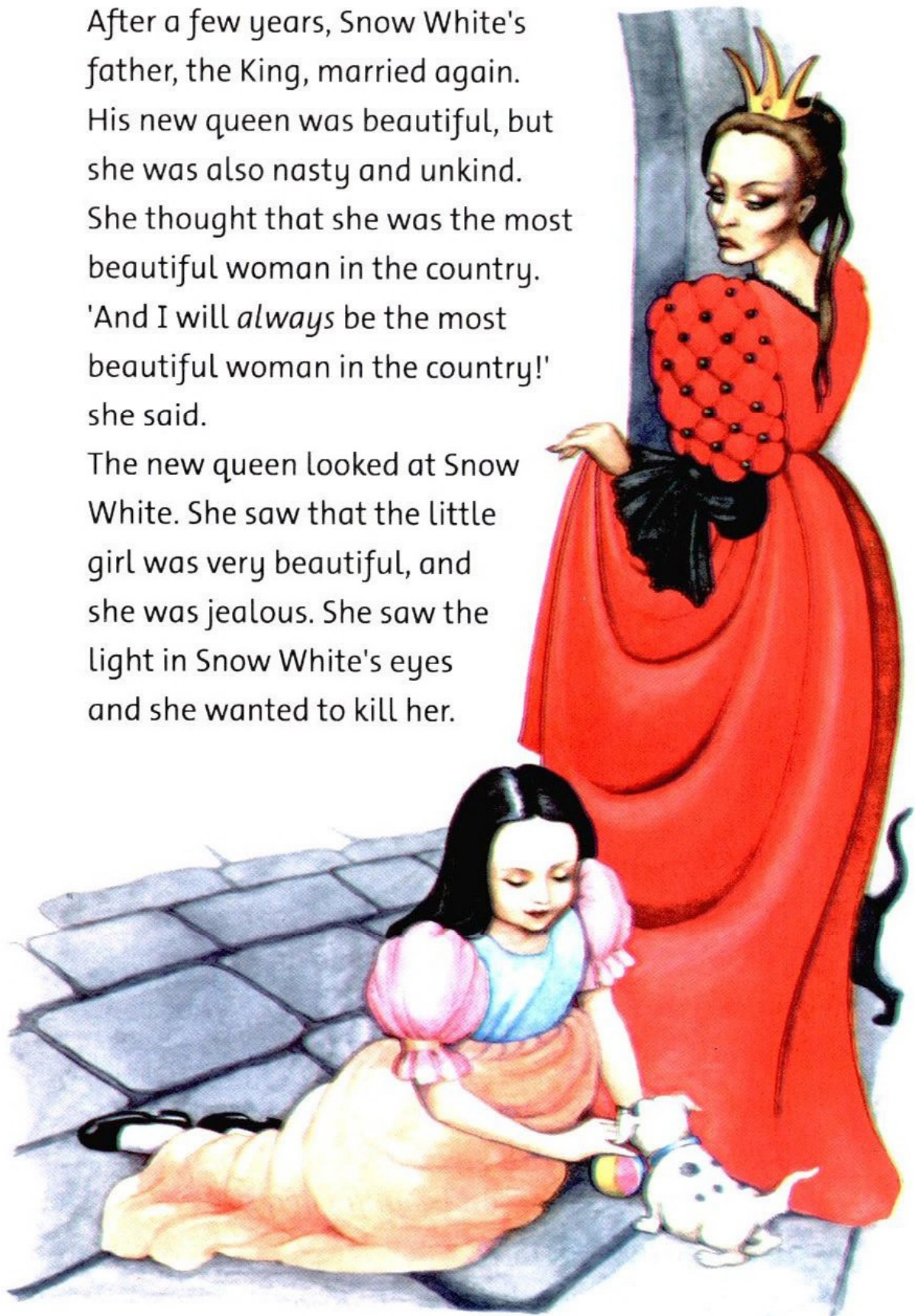
Soon the Queen had her baby, a little daughter. And the little girl had skin as white as snow, hair as black as trees in winter and cheeks as red as blood.

Time went by, but Snow White's skin was still as white as snow. Her cheeks were still as red as blood and her hair was still as black as trees in winter.

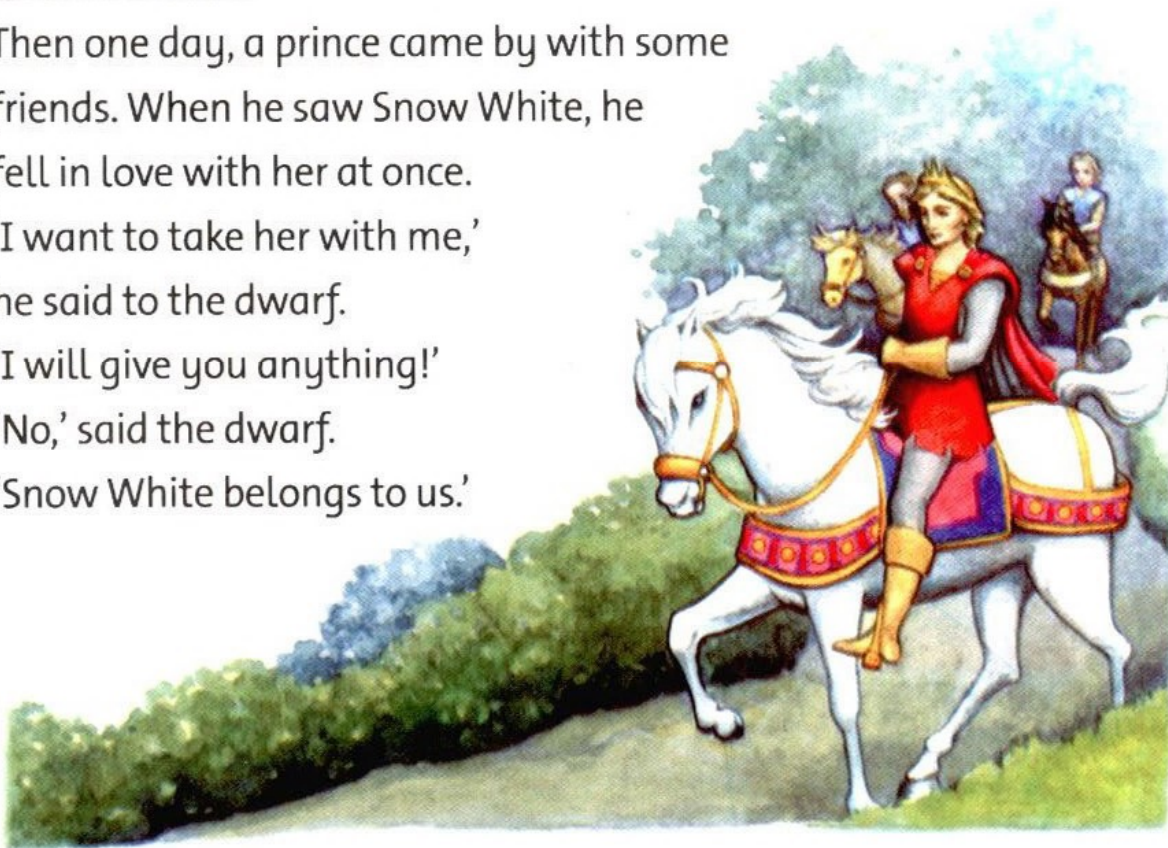
Then one day, a prince came by with some friends. When he saw Snow White, he fell in love with her at once.

At last, the dwarf said, 'Wait here. I will go and get my brothers.'

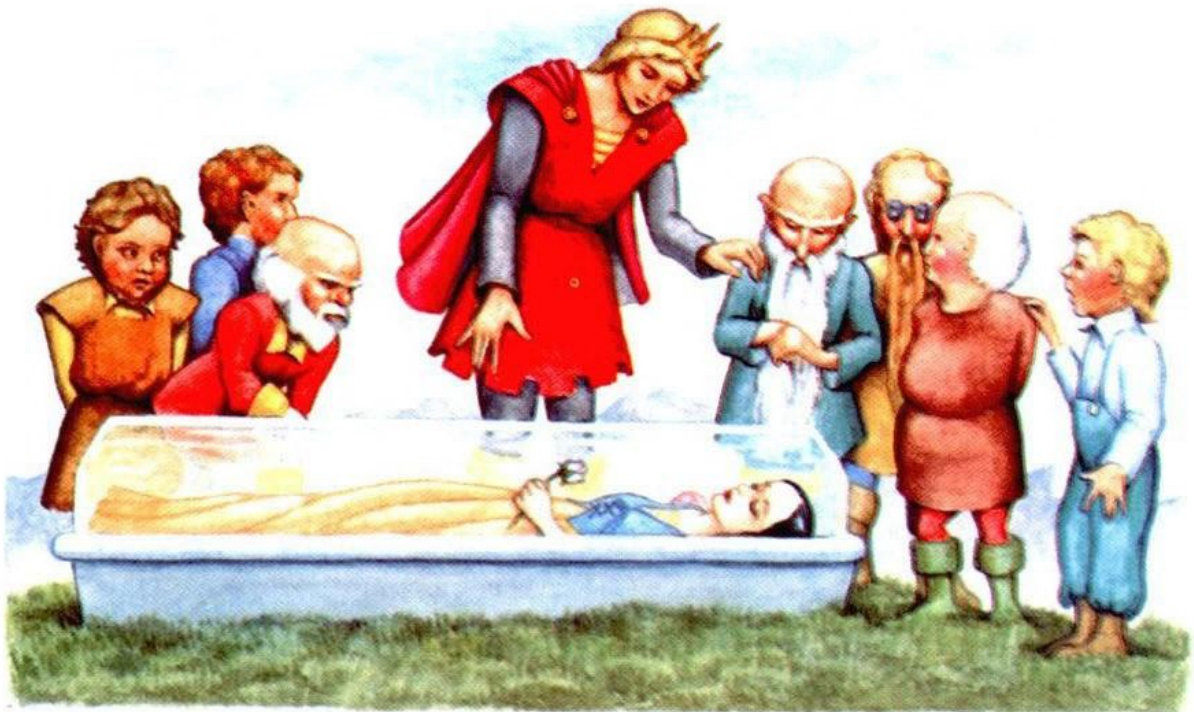
Then all the dwarfs came and stood in front of the Prince.

She opened her eyes and saw the Prince. When she saw him, she fell in love with him at once.

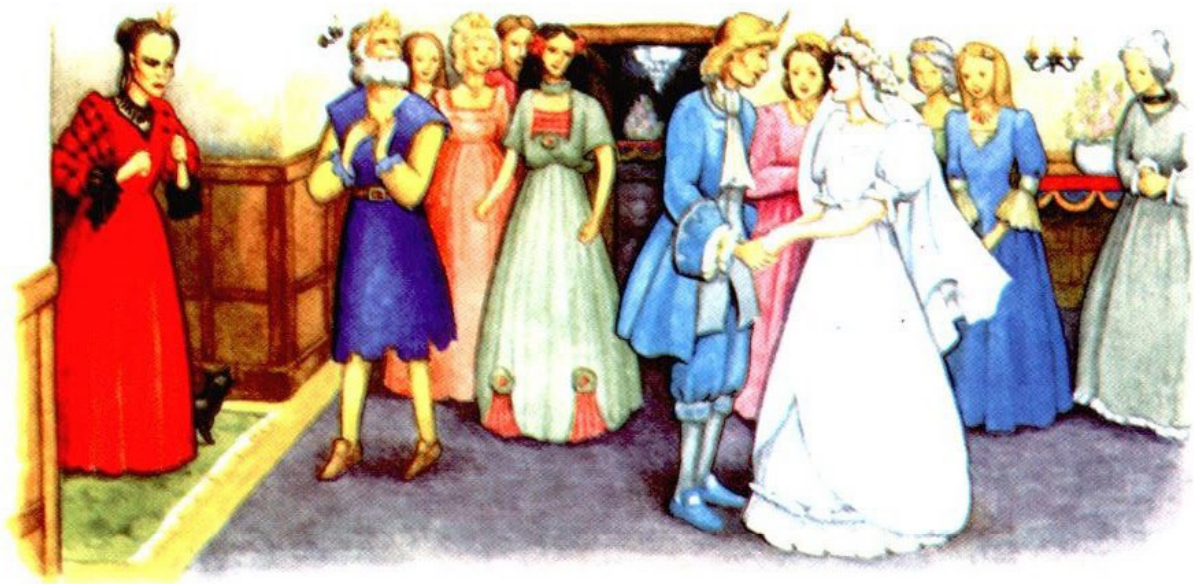
'Here you see your husband,' said the Prince. 'Will you be my wife?'
